FIELD NOTES

The community of Chapotin is located in the eastern part of Port-au-Prince in the Tabarre district. There are about 1000 people who live in Chapotin.

In September of 2016 we installed a hand pump well to provide drinking water to the people of Chapotin. Recently, the residents of this community alerted our local partners that the pump had broken. Due to political instability in Haiti, our local partners were unable to reach Chapotin for about a month after the pump broke. But at the first opportunity, and in spite of continuing political unrest, our local partners managed to reach Chapotin and fix the hand-pump. The community of Chapotin now once again is enjoying clean drinking water.

Through the efforts of this project, Solea Water sees a brighter future for the people of Chapotin. This future includes improved health, decreased infant mortality, decreased waterborne illnesses, increased time in the classroom for students, and an overall increase in the quality of life for the people of Chapotin.

PROJECT FUNDING

This project is funded by general donations to Solea Water, 100% of which go straight to the field.
